Career Guidance and Placement Cell of the College, in association with Sunrise Aviation, Florida, USA organized a seminar on 'Employability of Students in Goa, in Aviation Industry' on 11th October 2022 at the campus seminar hall at 12.00PM.

Mr.Ujjwal Thengdi, the Founder &CEO of Aviation Business and Career Leadership Institution. Mr Ujjwal Thengdi spoke to the students about Aviation Sector, giving insights on Aviation courses, its growing trend and its increasing interest among the youth. 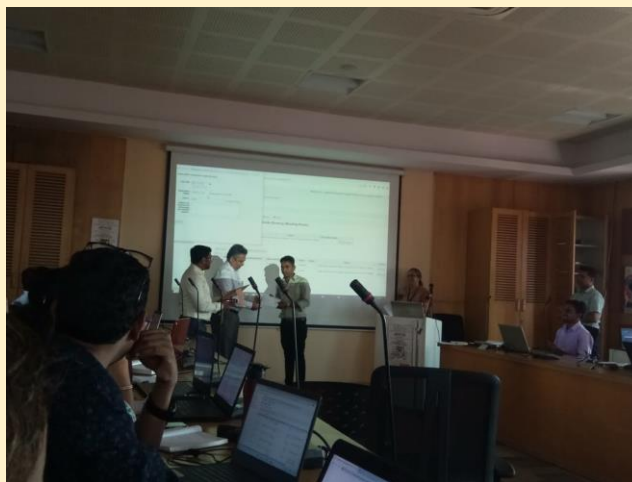
PRACTICAL WORKSHOP ON FILING OF GST RETURNS
