Research Methodology Course:

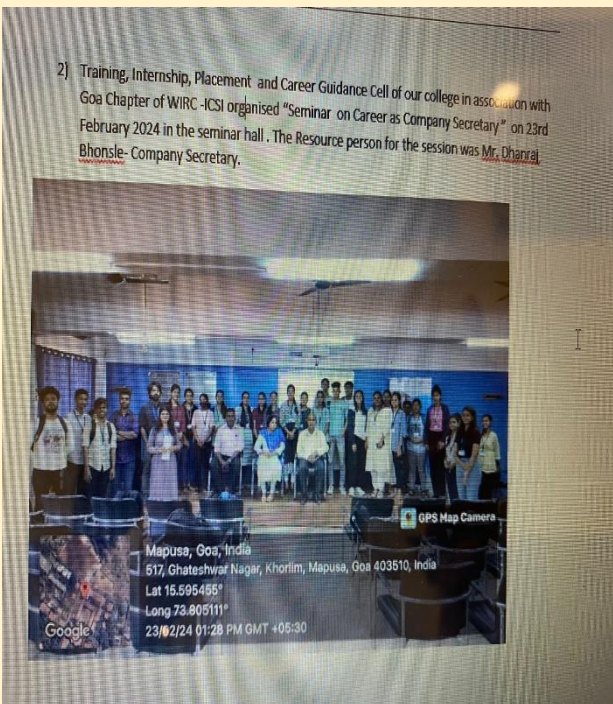
Twelve faculties from our college conducted a sessions on varied topic of research. 120 students were awarded certificates for successfully completion of course.
