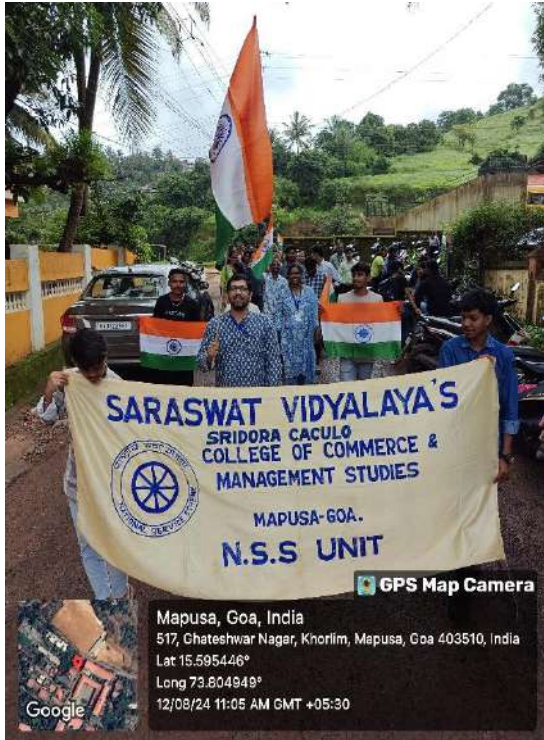
7) NSS Inauguration on 10th August 2024

September 2024. The event aimed to promote environmental sustainability and emphasise the importance of afforestation in combating climate change.

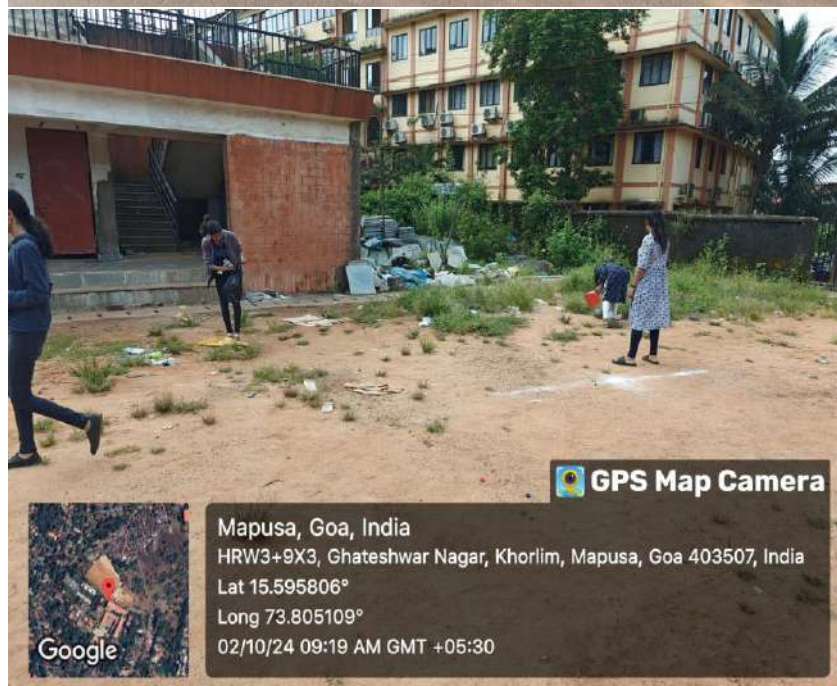

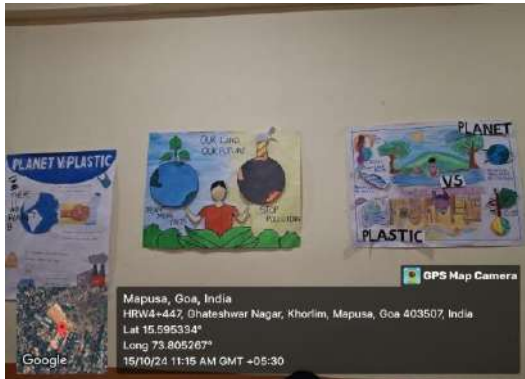
Biodiversity of Goa
